

The Rainbow Scarf

with pointed ends and tassels



This is a plain and simple knit allowing the yarn to speak for itself.

Materials:

Yarn: 100 g Kauni Effektgarn, colour EQ – Rainbow (or the colour/yarn of your preference)
Alternative yarn suggestion is Schoppel Wolle Zauberball DK.

Needle size: 4 mm

Stitch: Knit garter sts throughout

Final measurement: Approximately 140 cm, from point to point x 25 cm wide

Abbreviations: inc = increase; sts = stitches; beg = beginning; K = knit;
dec = decrease; tog = together

Pattern: Knit garter sts throughout. Cast on 3 sts on needle size 3 mm, K 1 row without inc.
Row 2: *K1 sts, in next sts inc 1 sts by knitting into front and back of sts and complete row knitting garter sts*. Repeat from * - * until you have 51 sts on the needle. Increases are now completed; continue knitting garter sts on all rows until straight piece measures approx 1.20 meter.
Now start dec at beg of next row, *K1 sts, K2tog and complete row knitting garter sts*. Repeat from * - * until 3 sts remain on the needle. Cast off.

Assembly: Weave in ends and make 2 tassels with 30 strands (makes 60 yarn ends) of yarn (finished tassel should be approx 9 cm long). Sew tassels onto the ends of the scarf neatly.

Rinse the scarf gently in soapy water to soften the yarn, use a small squirt of white vinegar in last rinse to close the scales of the wool. Dry flat in shape. Pinning the end points into shape during blocking is recommended.

You have now captured the fantastic phenomenon of The Rainbow, all that remains is to tie it around your neck, smile and enjoy!
